# EXTERNAL EVENTS



We had the honor of welcoming H.E Dr. Amr Talaat, Minister of Communications and Information Technology, Mrs. Doreen Bogdan Martin, Secretary General of ITU, and Dr. Cosmos Luckyson Zavazava, BDT Director at ITU, to EUI's booth at ITU GSR 2023!

Being one of the first universities in the Middle East and Africa to specialize in communications and information technology has led to EUI's involvement in ITU GSR 2023.

During her participation in the FDC Summit Forum, Prof. Reem Bahgat highlighted in the panel discussion entitled (Future Participation of Females in Cybersecurity in terms of Reality, opportunities, and Challenges and their role in promoting the State's Efforts towards digital transformation) that Cybersecurity is a highly demanded discipline in Egypt during the current period, generally for both males and females. Female students range from 20 to 25%, and almost half of the total number of computing and information technology students. High enrollment comes from the importance of this specialization and its role in preserving and protecting data against cyber theft and digital systems from cyberattacks.



Prof. Ahmed Hassan, EUI's Vice President for academic affairs, was invited as a keynote speaker at the 2nd Annual Conference of Post Graduate Studies for Applied Science at Benha University to discuss top trends in Computer, software, and artificial intelligence.



Dr. Amani Eissa, Head of Business Development, was invited to be a keynote speaker for the session "Technological Development and its Impact on Performance - Artificial Intelligence and Data Analytics" at the Main Hall of the Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources in the spirit of exchanging knowledge and in response to the official invitation sent by the Egyptian Natural Gas Holding Company (EGAS) to Egypt University of Informatics.

In addition to this productive meeting, Dr. Amani gave an overview of EUI's faculties and spoke with representatives of the participating firms about possible internship opportunities for the various programs and tracks across the four faculties.



What part does the metaverse play in the digital future of Egypt? In a two-day workshop sponsored by Microsoft and the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, officials of several key Egyptian ICT institutions came together to develop a proposal for Egypt's Metaverse Strategy.

Dr. Amani Eissa, the head of business development at EUI, was asked to give her ideas and perceptions on applying metaverse technology in many fields, such as scientific research, education, and training. The main application cases that could have a positive economic, social, and technological impact on Egypt were discussed throughout the workshop.
