Ahmed Elgendy on top of Forbes "30 under 30" class of 2024



Our very own Paris Olympics 2024 Gold Medalist and beloved EUIan, Ahmed Elgendy, continues to shine brightly beyond the arena. His remarkable achievements both on and off the field have earned him a well-deserved top rank on the Forbes Middle East 30 Under 30 Class of 2024 in the Sports & Entertainment category!

Ahmed Elgendy named Best Senior Male Player of the year

Ahmed Elgendy, EUI's Olympic champion, has been awarded the prestigious title of "Best Senior Player of the Year" at the 73rd Union Internationale de Pentathlon Moderne (UIPM) Congress held in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. This comes on the heels of Elgendy's breathtaking Gold Medal victory at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, cementing his position as one of the world's top modern pentathletes.

EUI congratulates Zeina Amer and Mohamed Elgendy, students at the Faculty of Business Informatics, on their outstanding performance at the World Universities Championship for Modern Pentathlon in Kaunas, Lithuania (Aug 21–26, 2024).

Zeina secured two gold medals in the team relay events, recording the fastest obstacle course times (31 and 55 seconds) and excelling in the laser-run. Mohamed achieved a personal best of 39 seconds in the obstacle course, finishing 7th in the individual boys' event.

EUIans Explore Whale Valley's Ancient Wonders

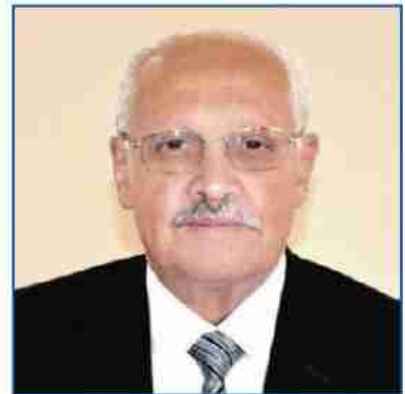

Seminar on " Plasma and Its Applications"

Prof. Mohamed Saleh Provides Expert Insights at INP Workshop for Egypt's SDG Simulation Model

Prof. Mohamed Saleh, Dean of the Faculty of Business Informatics, participated as a system dynamics modeling expert at the first stakeholder workshop for Egypt's Integrated Simulation Model for Sustainable Development Goals (iSDG), held from September 9 to 11, 2024, at the Institute of National Planning (INP). This workshop, organized by INP in collaboration with the Economic Governance Project (funded by USAID) and the Millennium Institute, introduced the key features of the simulation model designed to help Egypt achieve its SDGs.

This workshop aimed to explain the model's system dynamics approach and offer insights on refining its macroeconomic, social, and environmental components. The contributions of all participants helped enhance the model's accuracy and effectiveness in supporting Egypt's Vision 2030 and its future use in policy-making and national planning.

Prof. Hala H. Zayed's Groundbreaking Research on Deepfake Detection Now Indexed in Scopus!
